NEWS FROM NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER

Your godchildren are growing and super healthy! Among the camera trap images, we registered the couple taking care of the chicks. Your nest received some visitors who accompanied the field activities of the Hyacinth Macaw Project and everyone learned and understood the importance of conservation of hyacinth macaws and all the Pantanal biodiversity!

At 89 and 88 days old they were ringed, measured and we put a nanochip in the chest muscle. We also collect blood samples to find out if it is male or female. By the end of December, the chicks were with 94 and 93 days old, very close to the flight! We wait for the baptism name of your godchildren!
